To be clear - The Village of Whiting does not, nor has it ever had a Facebook page. The Village did not create, nor do we administer or provide content on the Facebook page titled 'In the Village of Whiting'. When the Village of Whiting decides to create a Facebook page we will notify our residents, by newsletter and the Village's website.

Animal Control in the Village

As we progress into spring and warmer weather more people will be using our wonderful paths and trails. This means there will be walkers, bikers, runners and dog walkers all using the trails at the same time.

Recently we have received complaints about dogs that are running loose on our trails and the Green Circle Trail. Running loose is considered to be when an animal is off the premises of its owner and not under the control of the owner.

Wisconsin, Portage County, Whiting, Stevens Point and Plover all have similar ordinances that ban animals from running loose. In addition, the Green Circle Trail has a more restrictive regulation, which requires pets to be restrained by a leash or tie not more than eight feet long.

This is a safety concern. A collision with a bike and a dog could result in serious injury to the biker and the animal. Aggressive dogs not under complete control of the owner could cause injury to other people and dogs.

Please be considerate of others when walking your dog in the village. While only the Green Circle Trail requires dogs to be leashed, it is only common courtesy to have your dog on a leash at all times when off your premises.
