### Hello and Happy Fall to all!

With fall comes raking leaves and fall clean up! Please keep in mind that the **compost hours on Mondays and Wednesdays are from 8am to 6pm** and **Saturdays from 10am to 2pm.** Jeff Vaughter has graciously offered to lock up the compost site on Mondays and Wednesdays. Thank you so much for volunteering to do this Jeff! If this has been a benefit to you, please let your trustees or any village employee know so that we know if has been worthwhile and worth continuing.

**Election day is Tuesday, November 5**. Voting takes place at the Village Hall from 7am-8pm. Register to vote at <a href="https://myvote.wi.gov">https://myvote.wi.gov</a> or in person at the office. A photo id and proof of residency is required. You must have lived here at least 28 days before election day to vote in The Village of Whiting.

### WINTERTIME REMINDERS

- Property owners and occupants are responsible for removing snow and ice from sidewalks within 24 hours after the snowfall ceases. (Village ordinance 12.07)
- The village encourages residents living near a fire hydrant to help us keep the hydrants clear of snow, which will allow faster access to the fire department in the event of a fire.
- · Removing snow from private property and depositing on sidewalks, streets or other public places is prohibited.
- When ice has formed and cannot be immediately removed, residents should use salt, sawdust or sand to cover the area.
- Sand barrels are available on corner of Verrill and School St., behind the Village Hall and on corner of Cherry and West Cedar. Bring your own bucket and fill from the barrel.
- **Please note** that the Village and our snow removal contractor are not responsible for any damage to turf, plow markers or other land-scaping near the road.

### HOLIDAY REMINDERS

- Trick or Treating hours: Thursday October 31 from 5-8 pm (coinciding with Plover and Stevens Point)
- Compost site will be open until November 20. Current hours remain: Mondays and Wednesdays 8-6 and Saturdays 10-2.
- The village will be closed on the following holidays:

November 28 and 29 (Thanksgiving)

December 25 and January 1 (Christmas and New Year's Day)

- Garbage will be picked up on Saturday instead of Friday for the weeks of Thanksgiving, Christmas and New Years.
- Christmas (real only) Tree pick up will be Wednesday January 8. Please place tree on curb by 9:00 a.m. with all lights, decorations, tinsel etc. off. Also keep in mind that the tree must be visible, so make sure all snow is removed if it happens to snow that day. Thanks for your cooperation! We will pick up your tree on that day or by Friday of that week.

Dog and Cat licenses will be available for the 2025 year on December 1, 2024. Tags are sold from 12/1/24 through 3/31/25. You can purchase them in our office or at the Humane Society. **Please bring proof of Rabies vaccination and cash or check**. (made out to the Village of Whiting) **Prices for 2025 are the same as last year:** 

Neutered or spayed animals: \$14.00

Un-neutered male or female: \$24.00

• Additional late fee (after March 31, 2025) \$5.00

- We will be collecting unwanted Christmas lights and taking them to the Solid Waste Department in Plover. Please bring lights strands only to the Village hall by January 31, 2025.
