COMPOST HOUR CHANGES BEGINNING OCTOBER 13

We will be extending compost hours beginning October 13:

- Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday from 8:00-3:00. (Tuesday, Thursday and Friday are added days)
- Wednesday from 8:00-6:00. (No change from current hours)
- Saturday from 8:00-12:00. (No change from current hours)

Please bring your orange compost card with you. **The compost site will remain open until November 19.**

If you are interested in being on the Village Board of Trustees, elections will be taking place in April, 2026.

There are 3 trustee positions to fill for the 2026-28 term.

Nomination papers for the Spring 2026 election will be available for circulation on December 1 and are due in the Village office by January 6, 2026 by 5:00pm.

MISC INFORMATION

- The Village Board approved the new ordinance permitting ATV/UTV use on Village streets. Additional permits from the DNR and the DOT are required before ATV/UTV use can actually take place. We also need to work on signs which will be placed on some Village roads. We will let everyone know when all approvals are received.
- 2026 elections are right around the corner. You can register to vote or request an absentee ballot at <https://myvote.wi.gov> or in person at the village office. A photo id and proof of residency is required.

HOLIDAY REMINDERS

- **Trick or Treating hours: Friday October 31 from 5-8 pm** (coinciding with Plover and Stevens Point)
- **The village will be closed on the following holidays:**
 - November 27 and 28 (Thanksgiving)
 - December 25 and January 1 (Christmas and New Year's Day)
- **Garbage will be picked up on Saturday instead of Friday** for the weeks of Thanksgiving, Christmas and New Years.
- **Christmas (real only) Tree pick up will begin Wednesday January 7.** Please place tree on curb by 9:00 a.m. with all lights, decorations, tinsel etc. off. The tree needs to be visible, so please remove any snow that might be covering it. The staff will work picking up trees into their schedule, so if not picked up that Wednesday, keep it out and available for pick-up. Thanks for your cooperation!

WINTERTIME REMINDERS

- Property owners and occupants are responsible for removing snow and ice from sidewalks within 24 hours after the snowfall ceases. (Village ordinance 12.07)
- The village encourages residents living near a fire hydrant to help us keep the hydrants clear of snow, which will allow faster access to the fire department in the event of a fire.
- Removing snow from private property and depositing on sidewalks, streets or other public places is prohibited.
- When ice has formed and cannot be immediately removed, residents should use salt, sawdust or sand to cover the area.
- Sand barrels are available on corner of Verrill and School St., behind the Village Hall and on corner of Cherry and West Cedar. Bring your own bucket and fill from the barrel.
- **Please note** that the Village and our snow removal contractor are not responsible for any damage to lawn/property close to the road.

2026 DOG AND CAT LICENSES WILL BE AVAILABLE DECEMBER 8

Dog and Cat licenses will be available for the 2026 year on December 8, 2025. You can purchase them in our office or at the Humane Society. **Please bring proof of Rabies vaccination and cash or check.** (made out to the Village of Whiting) **Prices for 2026 will remain the same as last year:**

- Neutered or spayed animals: \$14.00
- Un-neutered male or female: \$24.00
- Additional late fee (after March 31, 2026) \$5.00

RECYCLING UPDATES

- We will be collecting unwanted Christmas lights and taking them to the Solid Waste Department in Plover. Please bring lights strands only to the Village hall by January 30, 2026.
- We will continue collecting old/unusable wax candles throughout the year. You can bring wax in its original container. They are used by ODC and made into fire starters. What a great way to use up old candles and support a wonderful organization!
